Selection method

Applications received by the deadline in accordance to the provisions of this notice, will be submitted to Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale dell'Abruzzo e del Molise "G. Caporale" (IZSAM), in its role of leading organisation of the HERMES Project Consortium. The HERMES Project Steering Committee will provide a comparative evaluation of the candidates' curricula.

The selective procedure aims to identify a shortlist of eligible candidates. The shortlist will be used for the designations. The Commission will draw up the shortlist according to the following parameters:

- Quality and type of the candidate's professional experiences relevant for the assignments
- Level of knowledge of the English language.

Terms and conditions of the contract

The contingent work contract will be conferred by Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale dell'Abruzzo e del Molise "G. Caporale" (IZSAM), in its role of leading organisation of the HERMES Project Consortium.

The appointed experts shall be remunerated at a fixed fee of 500 euros (the amount include all the costs and taxes at the expense of the Institute and the candidate) per working day (up to a maximum of 1,500 euros).

The contract defines every legal, economic, fiscal and social security aspects and contains the express clarification that the tasks will be performed by the appointee without the obligation of exclusivity and with no subordination towards IZSAM. The experts will have to report the results of their individual or collective activity as part of the HERMES Project peer-review team.

The specific assignments have to be carried out in compliance with the rules of the Erasmus+ Programme and the HERMES Project management procedures. The work performances will be carried out in IZSAM premises or remotely on IZSAM decision.

Terms and conditions of the application

The application shall be provided with:

- the **Curriculum Vitae**
- **Copy of a valid identity document in pdf format.**

The incomplete or unclear applications will automatically be rejected.

Failure to meet the requirements A1, A2, A3 and A4 shall cause the exclusion of the candidate from the selection. IZSAM reserves the right to withdraw the selection procedure, with substantiated decision, if requested by the public interest. IZSAM reserves the right to not confer the appointment also in case the selection is occurred.

IZSAM has the right to verify the truthfulness of applicants' declarations under the art. 46 and art. 47 of the DPR (Presidential decree) n° 445/2000. In case of false declaration, without prejudice to criminal penalties provided in the art. 76 of the DPR 445/2000, the applicant loses any benefit resulting from the measure adopted on the basis of false statement.
